- Item A 1 x Threaded rod (60cm) Carton 2
- Item B 1 x Rod connector nut Carton 2
- Item C 1 x Threaded rod (13.5cm) Carton 3




Item E - 1 x Locking nut Carton 2

Item F - 1 x Spanner (Tube shaped) Carton 3

Assembly Stages


Stage 1

Lay the top upside down so the central fixing point is facing upwards. Take the threaded rod **(Item A)** and screw this into the fixing point on the top until it is tight and secure.




Stage 2

Take the **Column** from Carton 2 and gently slide it over the threaded rod until it reaches the fixing point. Make sure the locking tooth on the Column drops into its matching slot on the **Top**.




Stage 3

Now column is in place. Screw half of **ITEM B** onto the threaded rod like pictured below.




Stage 4

Take the **Connecting plate (Carton 4)** and slot it into **Tapered column** as pictured below.




Stage 5

Screw Item C into the other end of the connector nut from Stage 3.




Stage 6

Slide the **Base (carton 3)** over the remaining **threaded rod (Item C)**. Make sure the locking tooth on the Base drops into one of the slots on the **Connecting plate (Carton 4)**.



Stage 7

The final stage of assembly. Screw the Locking nut (Item D) onto the threaded rod and tighten with the spanner (Item E).



Once the bolt has been fully tightened you can flip the table up the correct way. **You will require a minimum of 2 people for this.**

WARNING: DO NOT pivot the table on its top when turning over. Due to the weight of the base this could damage the top.
